Approval of Agenda and August 21, 2024 Board Meeting Minutes (see agenda attached): Approved

Treasurer Report: No Changes

Secretary Report: Deferred to next session

Communications committee report: Deferred until next session

Grant Requests:

After leaving amounts for Operating Capital, the total to apply to Grant night was \$141,000 to be applied equally to the four main programs - Child Abuse Prevention Committee, Community Health and Housing, Community Hunger and Mentoring, and Youth and Education. Americanism will be awarded approximately the amount that was granted last year but need to confirm with Jack Wilson.

The individual committees will determine how the grants will be applied within each program.

- Child Abuse Prevention Committee- 4 grant requests totaling \$65,000
- Community Health and Housing 6 requests totaling \$52,000
- Community Hunger and Mentoring 11 requests totaling \$54,000
- Youth and Education 16 requests totaling \$59,500
 - o Some requests do not benefit our service area and will be ignored
 - o \$16,000 earmarked for scholarships in addition to the grants
 - 2 for \$5,000
 - 1 for \$6,000
- Americanism 2 organizations but have not heard from Jack on any specific requests In addition to the Grants, will have \$16,000 in scholarship – see above and will allocate \$5,000 to the Angel Oak award

Total Grants, scholarships and awards – \$162,000 (141,000+16,000+5,000)

Will push for individual donations – either designated or undesignated. Had \$20,000 last year

That Peterson presented a motion to accept the allocation of 162,000. The motion was approved by Chis Stephenson and seconded by Bob Schick. All present agreed.

Deadline for committee recommendations is Oct 14th - the Monday before the next Board Meeting on Oct 16th.

Grant Night is Nov 6th

Other topics discussed

Ron Schildge discussed the need to members to complete their online profiles and requested we encourage the members to post their pictures and other relevant details on the Website. Chris Stephenson suggested that we provide a quick tutorial and distribute desktop guides on how to update the profiles in our next meeting.

Dave Berry brought-up the Maple Syrup business plan and it was discussed by the group. All agreed that the Club could not bear any financial burden or risk, so sales would need to be preorder and the transaction needs to between the purchaser and the company.

Hello ECK-S Board Members,

It was good seeing so many of you at yesterday's ECK-S Board Meeting. We have an update.

Since Jack could not attend, Thad met with him at the Dinner Meeting afterward to get his thoughts on the allocation for the Americanism Committee. Jack said \$5,000 is appropriate.

As a result, below are the adjusted amounts allocated to each of the Programs of Service Committees:

- Child Abuse Prevention Committee- \$34,000
- Community Health and Housing- \$34,000
- Community Hunger and Mentoring- \$34,000
- Youth and Education- \$34,000
- Americanism- \$5,000
- High School Scholarships- \$16,000
- Angel Oak Award- \$5,000

Total \$162,000*

But that number doesn't yet include individual donations earmarked to specific committees or charities.

Thus far, we have received one personal donation (\$1,500) earmarked to the Child Abuse Prevention Committee, which is not included in the numbers above. Hopefully, there will be more to come. Last year, we had over \$20,000 in personal contributions before Grant Night. As you meet with your committees, please let them know that individual members' donations are always most appreciated.
